LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Welcome Pioneers to Spring 2022!

Hello all:

I would like to give you a recap of what has been going on so far this year.

Since January we have still been doing Hug-A-Bears from our homes and keeping up with the demand by cutting, sewing, stuffing and delivering to various organizations. In addition, all year we have been collecting soft and hard goods for our FUNDrive, which has been a good fundraiser for our club. This year so far, we have brought in \$654.32, just by having people clean their closets and garages. We also have been collecting luggage and new clothing for Emerge! which is a domestic violence organization serving the Tucson and surrounding areas. Another great fundraiser we are having great success with is the Jim Click raffle. To date we have sold \$1,225 worth of tickets which is all profit to our club. This year, Jim Click also gave all of the participating 501c3 organizations an additional \$1000. All year we continue to do lap robes that are given out to nursing homes and also at Christmas to clients of Mobile Meals.

We have also announced our SACC scholarship winner as Carson DiMaria. He is attending the University of Arizona and was awarded \$1000. Please see his story below.

SUPPORTING OUR VETERANS




