Every month, the SACC Hug-A-Bears team makes over 100 bears and unfortunately, that isn't enough. Our local firemen and paramedics tell us how without these bears on their trucks and in their ambulances, they would be lost without them as they are a such a big help. One ambulance company advised they use 100 bears a month alone. Without our dedicated volunteers, we wouldn't be able to keep up with the demand.





This year, we lost one of our dedicated sewers, Ivey Stamper. She sewed these bears right up until almost her 103rd birthday. Ivey's daughter told us that working on these bears helped keep her going all these years. Ivey will be truly missed by our Hug-A-Bears team and filling her sewing shoes will be a big task.
